The Committee on Funeral and Cemetery Regulation met in Raleigh on Wednesday, April 23 at 1:00 PM to hear from representatives of the Board of Funeral Service, the NC Cemetery Commission and interested parties in regard to H-808, An Act to Merge the NC Cemetery Commission with the NC Board of Funeral Service. SUMMARY: The parties failed to deposit preneed monies for two contracts within five (5) business days of receipt. When Mr. Williams failed to file one contract, he sent a false confirmation notice to the consumer stating the contract had been filed with the Board.

BOARD ACTION: The Board entered into a consent order revoking the funeral establishment permit, preneed establishment and sales licenses, and funeral service license of the parties. The Board issued an embalmer license to Mr. Williams and will allow him to reapply for his funeral service license in two (2) years.
