DISCIPLINARY MATTERS:

CASE FILE NUMBER: V10-050; V10-066; C13-076.

LICENSEES: Colvin Funeral Home and Cremation Services (FE #111); Affordable Cremation Service of North Carolina (CR # 78); Henry Mitchell Colvin (FS #1031).

SUMMARY: In V10-050 and V10-066, Crematory did not obtain the correct signature or all required signatures for the cremation. In C13-076, Funeral Establishment overcharged for removal from the airport to the funeral establishment.

BOARD ACTION: The Board adopted a consent order accepting a \$1,000.00 civil penalty and ordered crematory and Funeral Rule continuing education. A refund was also required.

CASE FILE NUMBER: M13-012.

LICENSEES: Nelson Funeral Service (FE # 172 and 417; PNE # 890 and 536).

SUMMARY: Nelson Funeral Service did not keep preneed records as required on an inspection.

BOARD ACTION: The Board placed the preneed establishment license on probation for three months and ordered preneed continuing education.
